

Malbec

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Mont Rocher is a collection of wines made from grape varieties indigenous to the south of France, in a style that lets each express its varietal typicity and sense of place — pure, fruit-forward expressions shaped by altitude and a cooler climate.

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Old-vine Malbec grown on cool, elevated sites in the upper Aude valley, where altitude slows ripening and preserves freshness and definition in the fruit.

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Picked at optimal ripeness in early September, the grapes are destemmed and crushed before a three-week maceration, with pumping-over through the first ten days to extract carefully and completely.

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Deep in colour, with ripe plum, blackberry and cherry on the nose. Rich and rounded, with perfectly balanced tannins and a long, smooth, succulent finish.

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Cries out for barbecued meats or strong cheeses.
